



Instructional Design

- <u>Courses</u>: CHI315, CHI 325, CHI 515, CHI 525
- <u>Goal</u>: 3 pieces in clerical (隸書), regular (楷書), and running (行書) scripts, respectively, with the texts given.
- <u>Scripts</u>: (earlier: Caoquan Stele 曹全碑 or Yiying Stele 乙瑛碑) Ou Style 歐陽詢體; Zhiyong Style 智永體; Zhao Style 趙孟頫體
- <u>Preparations</u>: 3-week practice of character writing and whole piece creation (formatting skills)
- <u>Calligraphy Showcase</u>: class work exhibition; external contests and exhibitions



REFLECTIONS 感悟

- <u>Calligraphy</u>: prestigious and integral aspect of Chinese culture
- <u>Students</u>: enthusiastic; eager to learn; well capable of doing well
- <u>Teachers</u>: high standards for learning; possess knowledge of Chinese calligraphy; proficiency of 3+ scripts (隸, 楷, 行, etc.)
- Scripts: Oracle-bone 甲骨文, large seal 大篆, small seal 小篆, and cursive scripts 草書
